Arnott, Elizabeth	The Secret Lives of Murderers' Wives	Margot is glamorous, flamboyant, and sexy; staid, British-born Elsie yearns to be a news reporter instead of the "office girl"; and mousy housewife Beverley just wants a safe, happy home. But the three very different women have something in common: their husbands are all convicted serial killers, none of the woman knew until the day their husbands were arrested, and they are now treated as pariahs. When several young women are brutally murdered and the police seem unable to crack the case, the three launch their own investigation.

Writing was Sam Vetiver's first love and the only thing she ever wanted to do. But as she nears 50--and an editor's deadline for a novel she's unable to complete--she tells herself she would give up everything for the right man. Then Sam gets an unexpected fan letter from bestselling novelist William Corwyn, who asks to meet her at a Boston book talk, then invites her to dinner. Soon, a "dangerous distraction" that intensifies Sam's writer's block evolves into a steamy love affair with a man eager to help her complete her book.

Crum, Tiffany	This Story Might Save Your Life	Adventure-comedy podcasters Benny Abbott and Joy Moore have been best friends forever, and they're on the verge of a deal that will take their already-popular show, This Story Might Save Your Life, to new heights. Everything's great--if you discount fallout from a problematic ad sponsorship, a stalker whose attention has kept Joy housebound, and Joy telling Benny she wants to put TSMSYL on pause. Not to mention Joy's lifelong struggles with narcolepsy. When she and her husband Xander go missing, all the little cracks in the façade shatter like the broken window left behind in their wake. Benny must piece together what really happened even as suspicion falls on his shoulders--because the story just might save Joy's life.
Dallas, Sandra	The Hired Man	1937. It's been seven years since the dust storms started in Colorado. Folks can barely remember a time when the clouds were filled with rain instead of dirt, and when the fields were green instead of brown. High school student Martha Helen Kessler and her family are luckier than most; they still eke out a living from the land. Even so, evidence of the Dust Bowl's grim impact on families, especially on the women who bear the brunt of their husbands' frustration and their children's hunger, is everywhere.
Dean, Will	Adrift	Peggy and Drew, both aspiring writers, move to an isolated canal boat with their fourteen-year-old son. Peggy is the glue that holds their family together, even as their son is bullied relentlessly for his physique and his family's lack of money. But when Drew becomes frustrated by his wife's sudden writing success, he moves their boat further and further from civilization.
Douglas, Claire	The New Neighbors	The Morgans are a kind, retired couple who recently moved to their sleepy suburban street in Bristol where nothing ever happens. But to Lena it sounded very much like they were planning a crime.
Dugoni, Robert	Her Cold Justice	Her family and friends tell her she must be mistaken. Yet Lena can't stop thinking about that strange conversation. What if they really are about to do something terrible?

Edwards, Janet Rich	Canticle	As a teenager on her family farm, Aleys lives to pray and teaches herself Latin to read the Bible. When her father arranges her marriage, she runs away and takes up Franciscan orders. Her spiritual advisor, Friar Lukas, deposits her with the beguines in Bruges, a closed community of religious women who reveal other ways of worshiping God. Aleys's ability to read and translate the Bible marks her as different and dangerous, as do her miraculous healing abilities. Soon, Aleys is forced to make life-altering decisions to protect her sisters from the Church's scandal-sniffers.
Erdrich, Louise	Python's Kiss	Thirteen pungent stories conjure a tender strangeness, set amid the woodcut-like drawings of the author's daughter Aza Erdrich Abe.
Finn, Patricia	The Golden Boy	After an involuntary retirement from his high-flying Hollywood career, Stafford Hopkins has retreated to a luxury estate on Maui, along with his wife Agnes, both grimly resigned to life in a paradise where neither feels fully at home. Stafford is ready to retreat into himself, too, when a letter arrives with shocking news. Stafford has been named guardian of four children he didn't know existed: the grandchildren of his late childhood friend, Bobby Shepherd, whose ghost Stafford can no longer ignore.
French, Nicci	What Happened That Night	Tyler Green, convicted of murdering his friend Leo at a student house party in 1993, has been released after almost three decades in prison. He has always protested his innocence. On a warm evening in London, Tyler summons eight of his university friends who were present on that fateful night. Is it just a reunion - or something else? With wine--and accusations-- flowing liberally, the reunion descends into violent chaos, and one friend will end the night with their throat slit in the upstairs bedroom...the same way that Leo's was in 1993.
Guterson, David	Evelyn in Transit	Evelyn Bednarz grows up in the 1960s feeling restless in her small Indiana town. At 18, she leaves home and hitchhikes across the country. Interested in Buddhism, she stops at a Buddhist retreat center in New Mexico, where she carries heavy limestone to help build their temple in exchange for a place to stay. Back on the road, she meets a man named Scott in a bus station. They travel together and become lovers, until he makes the abrupt decision to leave her.
Harding, Robyn	Strangers in the Villa	Dive into this new psychological thriller about a couple rocked by infidelity who moves to a villa in Spain's Costa Brava to rebuild their relationship, only to welcome a pair of visitors who have no intention of leaving.

Hochhauser, Rachel	Lady Tremaine	Etheldreda is trying to hold her household together with her two daughters, her stepdaughter, and the only two servants willing to stay after her second husband died, leaving her with a title but no financial support. When an invitation to a royal ball arrives, it offers the chance to position all three girls for advantageous marriages, but also requires hard work and expense to keep up their pretense of status. The only person unwilling to pitch in is Etheldreda's spoiled, meek stepdaughter, Elin.
Hurtubise, Charleen	Saoirse	In Michigan, Sarah's childhood was defined by fear and silence. As a teenager, she saw a chance to escape and took it. Now, in 1999, she is an artist living on the rugged coast of Donegal, Ireland, where she is known as Saoirse (pronounced Sear-sha)--a name that sounds like the sea and means freedom in the language of her adopted country.
Inglis Hall, Lori	The Shock of the Light	A young British woman and her twin brother fight to remain close to each other as World War II threatens to tear them apart.
Jackson, Joshilyn	Missing Sister	When people who inflict violence get away with it, does murder become justice--and justified? Penny Albright is just a few shifts away from completing her training as a cop in Kennesaw, Georgia, when she pulls her first murder scene. She's shocked to realize she knows the victim: Danny Bowery, one of three men who raped her twin sister, Nix, several years ago, sending her into a spiral that ended in her eventual death by overdose.
Marshall, Kate	The Girls Before	Stranger is trapped in the dark, with only her imagination and the scribbles on the wall left by long-dead girls to keep her company. Nearly out of food and water, she makes one last attempt to escape. But if the door opens at last, will it mean salvation, or only the beginning of her fight to survive?
Martel, Yann	Son of Nobody	A literature scholar discovers an alternate account of the Trojan War. Harlow Donne, a Canadian PhD student, has left behind his failing marriage and his young daughter, Helen, for a year's scholarship at Oxford.
Mauer, Sara	A Good Animal	In rural Michigan, a sheep farmer's son who dreams of inheriting his family's land falls for a newcomer determined to leave. When one choice upends their plans, both must reckon with futures they never imagined.
McVeigh, Georgia	Sorry for Your Loss	The story of two people, both as magnetic as they are dangerous, who get caught in an electric game of cat and mouse. The question is, who is the predator and who is the prey?

Mezghebe, Bsrat	I Hope You Find What You're Looking For	The year is 1991. Eritrea is on the verge of liberation from Ethiopian rule and in Washington, D.C.'s tight-knit Eritrean community, change is in the air. Thirteen-year-old Lydia and her family are grappling with what peace after decades of war might mean for their future, just as they welcome Berekhet--a distant cousin newly arrived from Ethiopia to attend medical school in the States. With him comes a barrage of new ideas Lydia must confront for the first time, about the stories of nationhood and family she was raised on.
Michaels, Fern	The Final Storm	In this exciting and richly moving new standalone page-turner, an acclaimed photographer who has overcome her difficult past is suddenly faced with a test of all her courage and resilience.
Muenter, Olivia	Little One	Ten years after leaving her father's cult behind, Catharine has built a life for herself in New York City. It's a hard-won freedom maintained through secrecy; no one can know who she is or what she gave up to escape. But when a reporter tracks her down and asks for her story, she risks everything she's built for the chance to find her sister.
